

WIZZ AIR AND GESAC RECONNECT SOUTHERN AND NORTHERN ITALY: NEW ROUTE FROM NAPLES TO TRIESTE

The route, launching on 14 December 2026, will operate with four weekly flights, every Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday.

Naples, 16 July 2026 – Wizz Air, Italy's second-largest airline by market share, and GESAC, the management company of Naples and Salerno Airports, today announced a major new travel opportunity for passengers: from 14 December 2026, a new direct route between Naples and Trieste will operate four times a week, every Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. Tickets are available from today on the Wizz Air website and via the WIZZ app, with fares starting from €19.99.

The introduction of the new route represents a further step in strengthening domestic connectivity from Naples Airport, reinforcing Capodichino's role as a strategic hub for links with Northern Italy.

The announcement comes amid Wizz Air's continued growth in Naples. Since launching operations in 2004, the airline has carried a total of 6.8 million passengers and today, with a 9.6% market share, is the airport's third-largest airline.

In Naples, Wizz Air now serves 25 routes across 13 countries and continues to expand its offering thanks to the strengthening of its local base. For the summer season, Wizz Air is offering 1.1 million seats from Naples, up 127.9% compared with Summer 2025; total seats available this year amount to 1.6 million, an increase of 78.1% year-on-year.
