United Airlines Extends Seasonal Service Between Naples and New York/Newark

United is offering up to eleven daily nonstop services from Italy to the U.S. for Summer 2024.

NAPLES, 9 April 2024 - United Airlines has extended its daily non-stop seasonal service between Naples and its hub at Newark Liberty International Airport, with flights starting almost one month earlier for 2024. With twice daily flights during the summer peak, United's service from Naples is set to operate until 26 October 2024.

The extended seasonal service between Naples and New York/Newark builds on United's existing year-round daily services from Rome to New York/Newark and from Milan to New York/Newark, as well as seasonal daily flights from Rome to Chicago O'Hare, Washington Dulles and San Francisco, from Milan to Chicago O'Hare and from Venice to New York/Newark. United is offering up to eleven daily nonstop services from Italy to the U.S. for Summer 2024.

"We are excited to return to Naples with an extended season for 2024, enabling our customers in southern Italy to book their next U.S. getaway even earlier this year," said **Walter Cianciusi, Country Sales Manager Italy, United Airlines**. "For summer 2024, United will operate its largest-ever transatlantic summer schedule in its history, offering even greater travel choice and the possibility to connect seamlessly via our U.S. hubs to onward destinations across the Americas."

"The extension of United's Naples/Newark flight, the first American major airline to fly from Naples to New York, proves the strong demand and the huge connection between the two cities, which share cultural vivacity and latitude," said **Roberto Barbieri, CEO of GESAC**. "The great success of these years has led the company to double the daily frequencies at summer peak and to focus on a product distinctly business, choices fully in line with GESAC's strategy to offer quality flights that guarantee high connectivity. Beyond New York, the connection with New York/Newark, hub of United, will allow passengers from Naples and Southern Italy to reach the entire American continent more easily."

The extension of service from Naples to New York/Newark underlines United's leadership among U.S. airlines as the largest carrier across the Atlantic, flying nonstop from 37 transatlantic destinations for summer 2024, the most in its history and more destinations than all other U.S. carriers combined. United continues to be the only airline to directly connect the U.S. with Dubrovnik, Malaga, Mallorca and Tenerife. The airline's 2024 schedule also includes new services from Marrakesh to New York/Newark (subject to government approval), Athens to Chicago O'Hare, Barcelona to San Francisco, the resumption of its seasonal Reykjavik-New York/Newark service, as well as additional flights from Rome. United will also increase its summer seasonal Malaga-New York/Newark flight to daily service and will start the service earlier on 3 May 2024. Additionally, the airline will be resuming earlier some of its other most popular seasonal routes from Nice, Lisbon, Barcelona, Rome and Milan to give customers more time and flexibility to explore destinations across the U.S.
